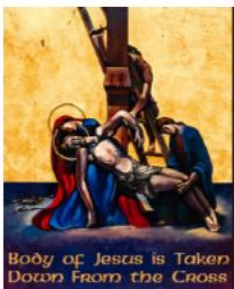

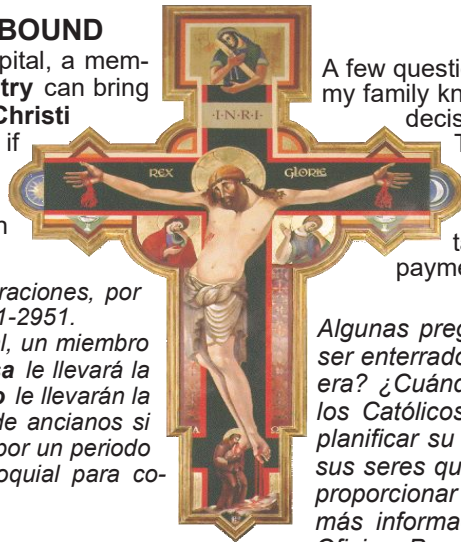


EUCCHARIST FOR SICK OR HOME BOUND

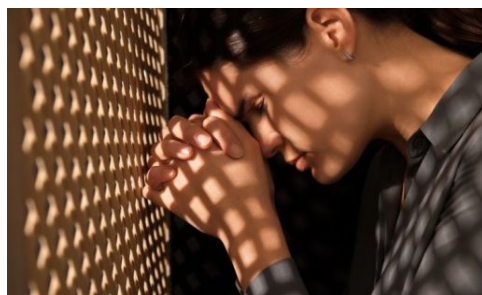
